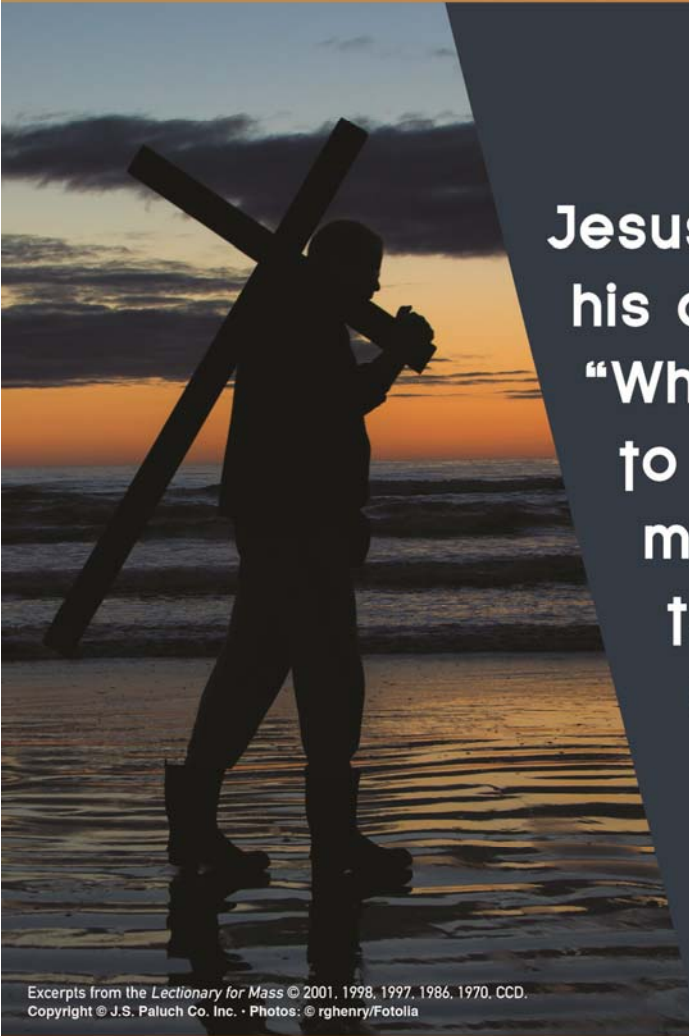

## SAINT GREGORY THE GREAT (540-604)

Imagine, fourteen hundred years after death, boasting a best selling CD! Yet outside the Church and within, Gregorian chant is enjoying a renaissance. Still, the timeless sacred music that bears his name is but part of Gregory's legacy. Renouncing civic service for monastic life, Gregory's administrative and diplomatic skills prompted continual summons from the cloister. Papal ambassador and advisor, he was eventually elected pope himself, renowned as a wise steward of the church's material possessions, generous benefactor of the poor, sponsor of missionaries, and promotor of monasticism. His liturgical enrichment of the Church endures not only in Gregorian chant, but in eloquent homilies still gracing the Liturgy of the Hours, the "Gregorian Canon" (Eucharistic Prayer I), and his spiritual classic, *Pastoral Care*, once presented to new bishops at ordination. Of countless impressive papal titles—Supreme Pontiff, Vicar of Christ, Successor of Saint Peter, Prince of the Apostles—the title still so cherished that it heads official documents is the one Gregory coined to describe his papal ideal: Servant of the Servants of God. Together with being designated "the Great," a fitting epitaph.

## From the Pastor's Desk

### *My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!*

The pandemic has had a great impact on our lives and our parishes. As churches reopen, parishioners are understandably concerned about returning to worship due to social distance recommendations and their own health. Yet, throughout this crisis, renewal remains of utmost importance in our parishes and in our hearts. We know as an Archdiocese that the way to spiritual renewal is through a focused effort on missionary discipleship, igniting the fire of Jesus in our own hearts and sharing that with others through hospitality, community outreach and ministry.

The Renew My Church movement begins with a "Discernment and Decisions phase" in each grouping. This process focuses on structural renewal and the best physical configuration within a grouping, for example the best use of resources to support strong parish staffs and have buildings, parking lots, etc. that support ministry. Once this has been determined, teams begin to focus on spiritual renewal and the vitality and vibrancy of parish life. Based on the current climate, we need to move to the spiritual renewal phase as efficiently as possible.

For that reason, the Archdiocese has moved up the start date for our grouping's discernment and decisions phase. We were originally scheduled for 2021-22. We will now start the process this fall, likely mid-October, and possibly using virtual meetings.

This basically means a small group of parishioners from St. Albert the Great will meet with other parishes in our grouping to evaluate the needs of our local areas and scenarios for structural changes that best suit our communities. The results of this process vary – from significant consolidations in areas with large financial and vitality challenges to changing Mass schedules or more opportunities to coordinate ministry with a neighboring parish in areas with stronger organizational and structural foundations.

Other than the timing, this process will remain largely the same as it would have been otherwise. There will be ample time given for prayerfully considering various scenarios and sharing ideas with the grouping team. Our focus throughout the entire process will be on renewal by making disciples, building community, and inspiring witness, with the first Discernment & Decisions phase focused on the organizational and physical structures needed to support those imperatives in our times. More details will be shared in the coming weeks.

### THE CROSS OF JESUS

The perception of a cross changed dramatically after Jesus' crucifixion. Before that event, death on a cross was not only horrible, it was degrading. It was a penalty reserved only for the most wretched of criminals. The word "glory" would not have found its way into the same sentence containing the word "cross." But all that changed with Jesus. Over time, believers began to venerate and honor the cross. They painted, sculpted, and carved images of it. Many lost their own lives for their association with it. Today our reverence for and relationship with the cross recalls little of the contempt originally associated with it. ## Z biurka Ks. Proboszcza

### Moi Drodzy Parafianie i Goście!

Pandemia wywiera ogromny wpływ na nasze życie i na życie naszych parafii. W miarę jak kościoły są ponownie otwierane, parafianie, ze względu na konieczność zachowywania dystansu społecznego i troskę o własne zdrowie, co łatwo zrozumieć, obawiają się powrotu do uczestniczenia w nabożeństwach. Jednak przez cały czas tego kryzysu odnowa pozostaje sprawą najwyższej wagi w naszych parafiach i w naszych sercach. Jako Archidiecezja wiemy, że droga do duchowej odnowy wiedzie przez systematyczny i trwały wzrost grona uczniów – misjonarzy Jezusa, rozpalanie ognia Jezusa w naszych sercach i dzielenie się Nim z innymi poprzez gościnność, wychodzenie naszej wspólnoty do innych i dzieła duszpasterskie.

Inicjatywa Odnów mój Kościół rozpoczyna się w każdej grupie od „fazy rozeznania i decyzji”. Proces ten koncentruje się na odnowie strukturalnej i najlepszej konfiguracji zasobów materialnych w ramach grupy. Przykładem może tu być najlepsze wykorzystanie zasobów w celu wsparcia kompetentnego personelu parafialnego, posiadania trwałych budynków, parkingów, itp., które będą w jak najlepszy sposób służyły w wypełnianiu służby. Kiedy to zostanie już ustalone, zespoły zaczną koncentrować się na odnowie duchowej parafii i uaktywnieniu życia parafialnego. Biorąc pod uwagę aktualną sytuację, musimy przejść do fazy odnowy duchowej tak sprawnie jak będzie to możliwe.

Z tego powodu Archidiecezja przesunęła datę rozpoczęcia fazy rozeznania i decyzji naszej grupy. Pierwotnie planowano, abyśmy rozpoczęli tę fazę na przełomie lat 2021-22. Jednak, zgodnie z aktualnymi postanowieniami, proces ten rozpoczniemy jesienią, prawdopodobnie w połowie października, i najprawdopodobniej korzystając ze spotkań wirtualnych.

Oznacza to, że mała grupa parafian z parafii Św. Alberta Wielkiego spotka się z innymi parafiami w naszej grupie, aby ocenić potrzeby naszej okolicy i scenariusze potrzebne do dokonania zmian strukturalnych, które najlepiej będą służyły naszym wspólnotom. Rezultaty tego procesu są różne - od znaczących konsolidacji w obszarach o dużych wyzwaniach finansowych i małej aktywności wiernych, przez zmianę harmonogramów Mszy św., aż po możliwość koordynacji posługi z sąsiednią parafią w obszarach o silniejszych podstawach organizacyjnych i strukturalnych.

W procesie tym, oprócz zmiany terminu rozpoczęcia, w dużej mierze wszystko pozostanie takie samo, jak miało być uprzednio. Będzie wystarczająco dużo czasu na modlitewne rozważanie różnych scenariuszy i dzielenie się pomysłami z zespołem grupującym. W trakcie całego procesu będziemy się koncentrować na odnowie. Będziemy to robić przez pomnażanie grona uczniów Jezusa, budowanie wspólnoty i inspirowania do składania świadectwa. Pierwsza faza rozeznawania i decyzji skupi się na strukturach organizacyjnych i fizycznych potrzebach koniecznych do wsparcia tych imperatyw w dzisiejszej rzeczywistości. Więcej szczegółów zostanie udostępnionych w najbliższych tygodniach. Jak zawsze, zachęcam do kontaktu ze mną.
