conveys authority and responsibility. In the first reading, the symbol is specifically that of a key; but the second reading and the Gospel also speak of trust and leadership as they refer to the earthly church that Jesus established.

Cieszę się bardzo, że powoli wracacie do swojego drugiego domu-kościół. Z każdym tygodniem jest nas coraz więcej. Cieszę się widokiem wielu nowych twarzy w czasie niedzielnych nabożeństw. Proszę was zostaćcie na zawsze z nami i zaangażujcie się w różnych formach w życie naszej pięknej parafii (**marszałkowie, lektorzy, ministranci, dziecięce chóry, chór parafialny, członkowie Klubu Polonia, szkoły parafialne, Róże Różańcowe, grupy modlitwne i nadzwyczajni szafarze Komunii Świętej**). Cieszę się także tym, że wielu z was troszczy się o duchowy wzrost naszej wiary, nadziei, miłości, ufności i radości. My, wasi duszpasterze troszcząc się także o wasz duchowy wzrost pragniemy was poinformować że:

- w każdą sobotę o godz. 6:30 wieczorem w kościele jest celebrowana wigilijna niedzielna Msza Święta w języku polskim;
- serdecznie wszystkich zapraszamy do żarliwej i serdecznej modlitwy!

Pamiętajcie także o słowach **Pana Jezusa**, które są zapisane w Dzienniczku Świętej (**punkt 160**) siostry Faustyny Kowalskiej: „**Pragnę spocząć na twoich rękach, nie tylko w sercu twoim**”.

Podobnie rzecz ma się z relacją z Bogiem – częste przebywanie z Nim sprawia, że pozostajemy sobą, jednocześnie coraz bardziej otwierając się na bliźnich. Niejednokrotnie wypowiadamy się na temat ludzi, rzeczy czy też zaistniałej sytuacji. Aby była to rzetelna opinia, trzeba wcześniej dobrze poznać dane zagadnienie. To natomiast wymaga czasu. Piotr rybak stał się Opoką Kościoła. Łowił nadal, lecz już nie ryby. Zarzucał sieć słowa, by zdobywać dusze ludzkie dla królestwa Bożego.
