In the responsorial psalm we sing our longing to see God's face, and in the second reading John writes that we are God's children and will, in fact, see God "as he is". This is our hope. This is God's promise. Today we celebrate the triumph of those who already gaze on the face of God. From the Pastor's Desk

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

We continue the “**Renew My Church**” Campaign. There is a consideration for a parish grouping between St. Albert the Great, St. Gerald, St. Fabian and St. Louis De Montfort parishes. Each of the four scenarios proposed by the Archdiocese of Chicago are conversation starter for parishioners and no decisions have been made. These scenarios will be evaluated against the following criteria: **ministerial and spiritual needs of the parish, parishioner count and Mass attendance, pastor manageability, parish financial stability and facilities, school quality and financial stability.**

Scenario 1: St. Louis + St. Gerald unite as one parish.

Church configuration 1: Both churches continue to have Sunday Mass(es)

Church configuration 2: All Sunday Masses held at St. Gerald. St. Louis de Montfort moves toward formal closure.

St. Albert the Great remains in its current canonical parish structure.

St. Fabian remains in its current canonical parish structure.

Scenario 2: St. Louis + St. Fabian unite as one parish. (a parish focusing on Religious Education for youth)

Church configuration 1: Both churches continue to have Sunday Mass(es)

Church configuration 2: All Sunday Masses held at St. Fabian. St. Louis de Montfort moves toward formal closure.

St. Albert remains in its current canonical parish structure.

St. Gerald remains in its current canonical parish structure.

Scenario 3: St. Louis + St. Albert unite as one parish.

Church configuration 1: Both churches continue to have Sunday Mass(es)

Church configuration 2: All Sunday Masses held at St. Albert the Great. St. Louis de Montfort moves toward closure.

St. Fabian remains in its current canonical parish structure.

St. Gerald remains in its current canonical parish structure.

Scenario 4: St. Louis de Montfort Parish ceases as a parish and its territory and assets/liabilities are divided among the other 3 parishes.

Special meeting, for parishioners to discuss these proposals, will take place Wednesday, November 11, 2020 in Rogers Hall at 7:00 pm.

Moi Drodzy Parafianie i Goście!

Kontynuujemy program „*Odnów Mój Kościół*”. W poniedziałek (26 października) poznaliśmy przygotowane przez Archidiecezję Chicago specjalne scenariusze dotyczące naszych parafii. Dziś przedstawiamy je wam. W środę 11 listopada o godz. 7:00 wieczorem zapraszamy wszystkich chętnych parafian do sali pod kościołem, aby podzielić się swoim spostrzeżeniami na ten temat.

- *Scenariusz I: kościoły św. Louis de Montfort i św. Geralda połączone w jedną parafię.*
- *Scenariusz II: kościoły św. Louis de Montfort i św. Fabiana połączone w jedną parafię.*
- *Scenariusz III: kościoły św. Louis de Montfort i św. Alberta Wielkiego połączone w jedną parafię.*
- *Scenariusz IV: kościół św. Louis de Montfort zostanie zamknięty, a parafianie z tego kościoła sami zadecydują gdzie uczestniczyć będą we Mszach Świętych.*

W przypadku połączenia kościoła św. Louis de Montfort z wymienionymi parafiami istnieją dwie opcje:
- niedzielne Msze będą odprawiane w obu kościołach. Kościół św. Louis de Montfort będzie tylko kościołem dojazdowym jako kaplica.
- kościół św. Louis de Montfort zostanie całkowicie zamknięty do celów liturgicznych.

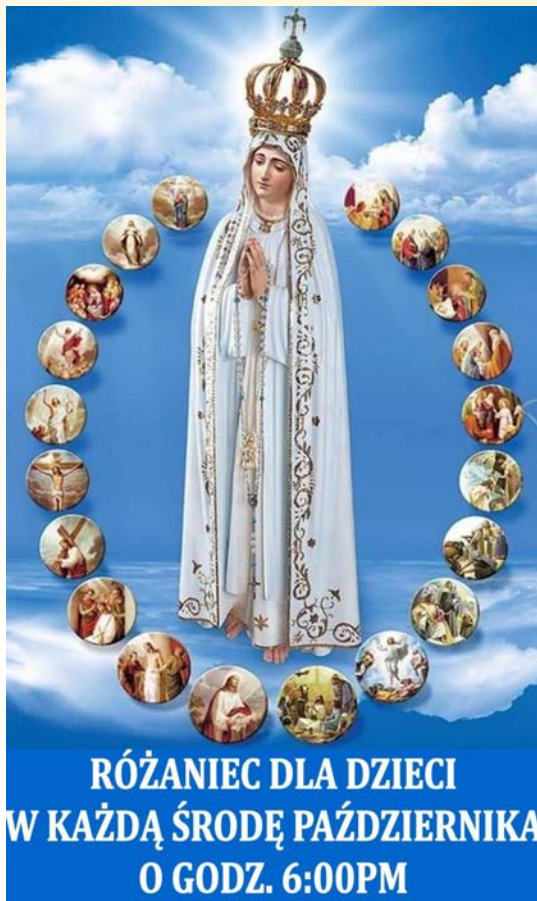

ŚWIĘTYMI BĄDŹCIE!

W dzisiejszą uroczystość – podobnie jak w Boże Narodzenie – grozi nam zagubienie istoty świętowania ze względu na wielość i bogactwo tradycji. Pośród grobów, zniczy, medialnych wezwań do zadumy, wyciszenia, Kościół tego dnia bije w wielki dzwon, abyśmy usłyszeli potężne wezwanie do świętości. I to powołanie jest dziś najważniejsze. Pięknie jest stanąć nad grobami najbliższych, pomodlić się, zapalić znicz, ale jeszcze ważniejsze jest przesłanie dzisiejszej Ewangelii, całej liturgii: świętymi bądźcie! A że to jest możliwe, widać w życiu ludzi takich jak my – św. Franciszka, św. Faustyny, św. Jana Pawła II. Dziś stają oni wszyscy pośród nas i mówią, że świętość jest możliwa, wprowadza się ją w codzienność i realizuje w konkretach dnia powszedniego. Oni już ją osiągnęli, a my walczymy. Jesteśmy jednak wezwani do świętości – to wynika z sakramentu chrztu, a nie np. święceń kapłańskich czy ślubów zakonnych. Jest też dobra wiadomość dla wszystkich zapracowanych – coraz bardziej docenia się ludzką pracę jako środek uświęcenia: „[...] praca może być środkiem uświęcania i ożywiania rzeczywistości ziemskich w Duchu Chrystusa” (KKK 2427). Warto więc, abyśmy, spotykając się z najbliższymi nad grobami, pomyśleli, że wszyscy święci są też dla nas taką dalszą „rodziną”. To oni się za nas modlą (szczególnie nasi wyjątkowi patroni) i to właśnie oni wyjdą po nas, gdy nasze ciało będzie już złożone w grobie. Warto już teraz się z nimi zaprzyjaźnić i śmiało zmierzać na spotkanie ze św. Franciszkiem, św. Janem Pawłem II, św. Faustyną i wszystkimi innymi świętymi.
