BLESSED MIGUEL AGUSTÍN PRO (1891-1927) November 23

Graham Greene’s classic *The Power and the Glory* immortalized Mexico’s persecuted Church of the 1920s. But photographs of Father Pro—arms outstretched to image Christ Crucified, kneeling in prayer before the firing squad, crumpled dead on the ground—vividly, visually remind us that not long ago, not far away, the faith we take for granted cost everything! Born to a mining family, Miguel became a Jesuit and was sent to study Catholic labor movements in Belgium in preparation for evangelizing Mexico’s workers. But he returned to find a Mexico determined to annihilate Catholicism, and, like priests before him during Roman persecutions, England’s Reformation, and in China today, ministered secretly to an “underground Church” until apprehended and sentenced to the firing squad. In his final moments, Father Pro blessed his executioners, forgave his enemies, and shouted: “*Viva el Cristo Rey!*—Long Live Christ the King!”—his defiant, dying proclamation of ultimate, transcendent loyalty. Father Pro’s martyrdom reinvigorated that beleaguered Church, whose countless faithful, never again afraid, would throng John Paul II when he visited Pro’s beloved Mexico fifty-two years later. —Peter Scagnelli, Copyright © J. 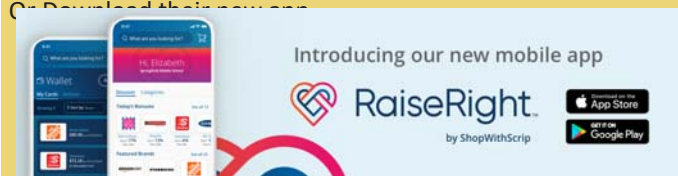

Moi Drodzy Parafianie i Goście!

Dziękujemy Ci za wolność i niepodległość oraz pamiętamy o tych, którzy nie zaznali wolności.

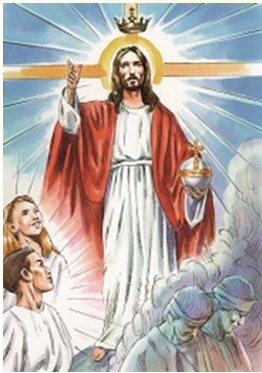

NOWE ZAGROŻENIA

„Pod wieczór życia będziemy sądzeni z miłości” (św. Jan od Krzyża). Wszystko, co czynimy, o tyle ma wartość, o ile w miłości ma swój początek. Dlatego istotne jest, kto lub co króluje w moim sercu... Pan Jezus, porównując siebie do pasterza, który oddziela owce od kozłów, dokonuje sądu nad wszystkimi narodami. Ze zgromadzonymi po swej prawej i lewej stronie prowadzi dialog, a najważniejszym tematem są uczynki miłosierdzia. Zapewne dla większości z nas podanie kubka wody spragnionemu, nie stanowi problemu. Tym, na co powszechnie narzekamy i czego nam brakuje, jest czas. Pochłanianie nas świat komputerów, co sprawia, że wielu ludzi funkcjonuje bardziej w świecie wirtualnym niż w rzeczywistym. Te nowe, pozornie nieszkodliwe zagrożenia, często doprowadzają do kryzysu, a nawet rozpadu rodziny. Żyjąc pod jednym dachem, tworzymy azyl w czterech ścianach własnego pokoju, zawieramy wirtualne „przyjaźnie”, które nie stawiają wymagań i niczego od nas nie oczekują. Niekiedy, zagłuszając wyrzuty sumienia, wspieramy charytatywne dzieła, równocześnie nie mając czasu na rozmowę z mężem, żoną, dzieckiem, przyjacielem. Stąd jawi się pytanie: kto lub co króluje w moim sercu? Jeśli jest to Chrystus, wtedy daję siebie najbliższym i na tym nie poprzestaję. Miłość bowiem rodzi miłość, zataczając coraz szersze kręgi. Z Chrystusem Królem wywyższonym we własnym sercu nauczymy się kochać i budować wartościowe relacje; nie poddamy się nowym zagrożeniom, bo otaczający świat stanie się o wiele ciekawszy i piękniejszy niż wirtualna samotność. *s.
