

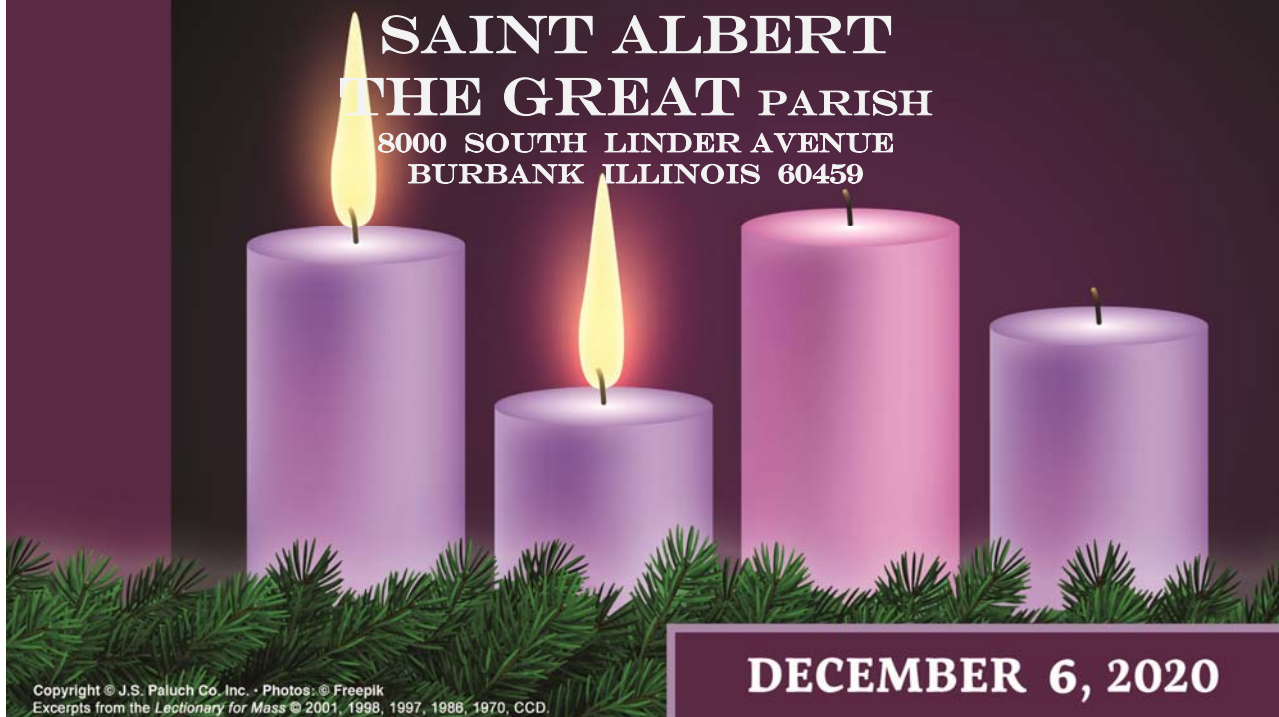

### **FEAST OF FAITH Watching for Christ's Coming**

In the season of Advent, we look to the coming of Christ at the end of time, and we prepare ourselves to celebrate his first coming among us at Christmas. Remembrance of the past is combined with preparation for the future. Memory meets action. In a certain sense, the Mass is an Advent prayer. At the Last Supper, Jesus did not tell his disciples, “Never forget what I did for you.” Instead, he said, “Do this in remembrance of me.” He calls us to remember by *doing*, to combine memory with action. In the celebration of the Eucharist, remembering and doing become one. Jesus is as present in our midst as he was in that upper room, breaking the bread and sharing the cup; but it is a new kind of presence, seen only with the eyes of faith. In the heavenly liturgy, there will be no need of sacraments, for there, “celebration is wholly communion and feast” (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 1136). Here, things are different. We have only glimpses and flashes of the beauty that is yet to be. And yet, in the liturgy, we truly participate in the heavenly liturgy. ## Z biurka Ks. Proboszcza

### Moi Drodzy Parafianie i Goście!

To już druga niedziela Adwentu. Pamiętajmy, że każdego dnia mamy być „**Apostołami Nadziei, Pokoju, Radości i Miłości**”. Jest to szczególnie ważne w tym trudnym czasie kiedy towarzyszy nam pandemia wirusa. Bądźmy wyrozumiali, życzliwi i miłosierni!

Dziś po każdej Mszy Świętej w przedsionku kościoła możemy zakupić piękne kartki świąteczne z wizerunkiem szopki Bożonarodzeniowej z naszej świątyni. Zachęcam was wszystkich do ich zakupu i rozesłania do swoich krewnych oraz znajomych. Również i w ten sposób możemy finansowo wesprzeć naszą ukochaną parafię.

Za tydzień natomiast 12 i 13 grudnia po każdej Mszy Świętej można będzie zakupić uszka, kopytka i pierogi (4 rodzaje) na stół wigilijny. Dochód z tej sprzedaży wciąż będzie przeznaczony na pokrycie kosztów budowy 20 sal lekcyjnych dla Polskich Szkół. Bardzo was proszę o pomoc!

Przypominam też o niedzielnej **Mszy Świętej-Livestream w języku angielskim o godz. 9:00 rano**. Proszę tylko odwiedzić naszą parafialną stronę internetową i nacisnąć specjalny link. Duchowo łączcie się z nami i ze swoją wspólnotą parafialną.

**Za tydzień podam dokładny rozkład Mszy Świętych w wigilię Bożego Narodzenia, w Boże Narodzenie i w święto św. Szczepana – pierwszego męczennika.** Ten rozkład znajdziecie w biuletynie parafialnym i na stronie internetowej parafii. Zapamiętajcie go proszę! Będą pewne zmiany, które podyktowane są obecną sytuacją związaną z wirusem Covid-19. Zapewniam szczególnie naszych Angielskojęzycznych Parafian oraz tych, którzy jeszcze nie wrócili do kościoła, że nabożeństwa w języku angielskim będzie można oglądać na bieżąco przez internet (**Livestream**). Kierując się dobrem duchowym oraz względami bezpieczeństwa musimy w tych nadchodzących dniach Bożego Narodzenia stworzyć więcej nabożeństw w języku polskim. Ale o tym już za tydzień. Uważajcie na siebie!

### Wyszli od Ciebie Pieszo.



Kto odwiedzi Ziemię Świętą, często może usłyszeć powiedzenie: „Jerozolima się modli, Tel Awiw się bawi”. Tel Awiw to najnowocześniejsze miasto w dzisiejszym Izraelu. To rzeczywiście miasto współczesnej kultury żydowskiej, przepełnione kinami, teatrami, salami koncertowymi, kafejkami i restauracjami. Tak jest dziś. Zaskakującym więc może wydawać się fakt, że tak nazywała się dzielnica Babilonu, w której osiedlili się Żydzi uprowadzeni w VI wieku przed Chr.

Paradoksalnie okres niewoli babilońskiej był dla Izraelitów czasem niezwykłego rozwoju religijnego i konsolidacji społeczeństwa. Wtedy zaczęły powstawać pierwsze synagogi, wtedy zredagowano Pięcioksiąg i zaczęto posługiwać się językiem aramejskim, którym mówił Jezus. Świadomy rychłego końca niewoli prorok Baruch mówi o wyгнаńcach: „Wyszli od ciebie pieszo, pędzeni przez wrogów, a Bóg przyprowadzi ich niesionych z chwałą, jakby na tronie królewskim”. Powrót z Babilonii zapowiadał także Izajasz, gdy wzywał do przygotowania dróg Panu. Tymi samymi słowami Jan Chrzciciel nawoływał do nawrócenia, udzielając przy tym chrztu nawrócenia. Właśnie nawrócenie prowadzi do wydawania plonu sprawiedliwości, o którym mówi Paweł apostoł w korespondencji z Filipianami.

Nie trudno dostrzec pewne analogie pomiędzy uciskaniem przez Babilończyków narodem wybranym a jarzmem stanu wojennego, którego wprowadzenie dziś wspominamy, modląc się za naszą ojczyznę. Modlitwą i hojnym darem wspieramy także Kościół na Wschodzie, który wciąż boryka się z niedostatkiem środków materialnych. ks. Mariusz Rosik
