This is what we, as God's holy family, are called to do each day: to trust not in ourselves and the way we think things should be, but to open ourselves and surrender ourselves in faith to a God of endless promise.

### FEAST OF FAITH

#### Processions

Why does the liturgy begin with a procession? It is not just a practical matter of getting the ministers of the liturgy from the sacristy to the sanctuary. The procession is a powerful sign of who we are as Christian people. We are not static, staying in one place. We are going somewhere. Our procession leads us to the altar, sign of Christ's presence in our midst. We move, we process, because we recognize our need for what Christ is preparing for us at that table. We go forward eagerly, because we are hungry for that heavenly food.

This procession is an orderly one: servers, deacon, priest presider. Each is set apart by distinctive vesture: albs for the altar servers, dalmatic for the deacon, chasuble for the priest. The procession is an image of the hierarchical structure of the Church. On a deeper level it is an image of unity in diversity. We are all on a journey to the heavenly city, but each of us is clothed with different gifts. We all receive the call to service, but not in the same way. Only by coming together in all our wonderful variety can we achieve the work of the kingdom.

#### **Kochać Boga i bliźniego w rodzinie**

Wpatrując się w przykład Świętej Rodziny, uczmy się przeżywać nasze życie rodzinne w harmonii, tego co boskie, z tym co ludzkie. Wizyta Świętej Rodziny w świątyni Jerozolimskiej podyktowana była tradycją Prawa Żydowskiego. Należało pierworodnego syna poświęcić Panu. Taki gest był wyrazem czci wobec Boga, który uważany był za Dawcę życia, a także uczył wdzięczności, za to co małżonkowie mogli otrzymać najcenniejszego, a mianowicie za dar pierwszego dziecka. W życiu nie powinniśmy nigdy zapominać o postawie wdzięczności. Odnosi się ona do Pana Boga, a także do osób, którym coś ważnego jesteśmy w życiu wdzięczni: rodziców, krewnych, czy dobroczyńców. Dzisiejsza niedziela przypomina nam o roli jaką odgrywa rodzina w życiu człowieka. Jest ona dla każdego z nas naturalnym środowiskiem wzrostu, tak w wymiarze religijnym, jak i ludzkim. W rodzinie uczymy się kochać Boga, ale także drugiego człowieka. Niestety nie wszyscy mogą cieszyć się pełnym szczęściem życia rodzinnego. Wiele rodzin doświadcza kryzysów, które nierzadko kończą się dramatem rozpadu małżeństwa i cierpieniem dzieci. Brak harmonii w życiu rodzinnym, wywołuje u dzieci wiele problemów natury emocjonalnej, co także negatywnie rzutuje na całe późniejsze życie. Obchodząc święto Świętej Rodziny módlmy się za współczesne rodziny, aby pozostając wiernymi Bogu i Bożym przykazaniom, potrafiły sprostać wyzwaniom, jakie stawia przed nimi świat. Aby potrafiły ofiarowywać Bogu swój cenny czas i nigdy nie zaniedbywały celebracji ważnych momentów życia rodzinnego.
