With this great gift comes a responsibility: to respond to the call with our own distinctive voice, to take time to discern exactly what our call is, to determine precisely what the will of the Father is for each of us.

FEAST OF FAITH The Gospel Reading

The climax of the Liturgy of the Word comes with the proclamation of the Gospel. Everything tells us that something important is happening. We stand. We sing special acclamations. Servers with candles and sometimes incense lead the deacon or priest to the ambo, where the reading is proclaimed from a special book.

All of the readings are important, but the liturgy directs special attention to the Gospel for a reason. “[A]mong all the inspired writings, even among those of the New Testament, the Gospels have a special place, and rightly so, because they are our principal source for the life and teaching of the Incarnate Word, our Saviour” (*Dei Verbum*, the Dogmatic Constitution on Divine Revelation of the Second Vatican Council, 18). In the Gospels, the narrative of Christ’s saving life, death, and resurrection continues to be proclaimed in our midst.

Our Sunday Lectionary is structured so as to allow us to hear as much of the Gospels as possible. The readings are arranged in a three-year cycle. In Year A, the Gospel readings are taken mainly from Matthew; in Year B, from Mark and John; and in Year C, from Luke. In this way, over the course of three years, we hear a substantial portion of all four Gospels. —Corinna Laughlin, Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

Od trzech tygodni Kościół cieszy się zmartwychwstałym Chrystusem. Treść modlitw, hymnów i pieśni przypomina radość Oblubienicy, która cieszy się powrotem Oblubieńca. Uczniowie zachwyceni są pojawianiem



się Pana. To On jest w centrum uwagi, to Jego życie jest najważniejsze jako owoc wskrzeszenia z martwych. Uczniowie radują się tym faktem, a Jezus pozwala im na tę radość. Liturgia dzisiejszej niedzieli, zwanej w tradycji Kościoła Niedzielą Dobrego Pasterza, dokonuje wyraźnej zmiany w rozumieniu łaski Zmartwychwstania. Wsłuchując się w treść czytań odkrywamy, że dzieło Jezusa nie tyle służy Jemu i Jego chwale, co dobru i zbawieniu ludzi, a cud nowego życia polega nie na mocy wskrzeszenia Syna, a zmianie życia, jakiej mogą doświadczyć sami zbawieni. Paschalna radość Kościoła nie
