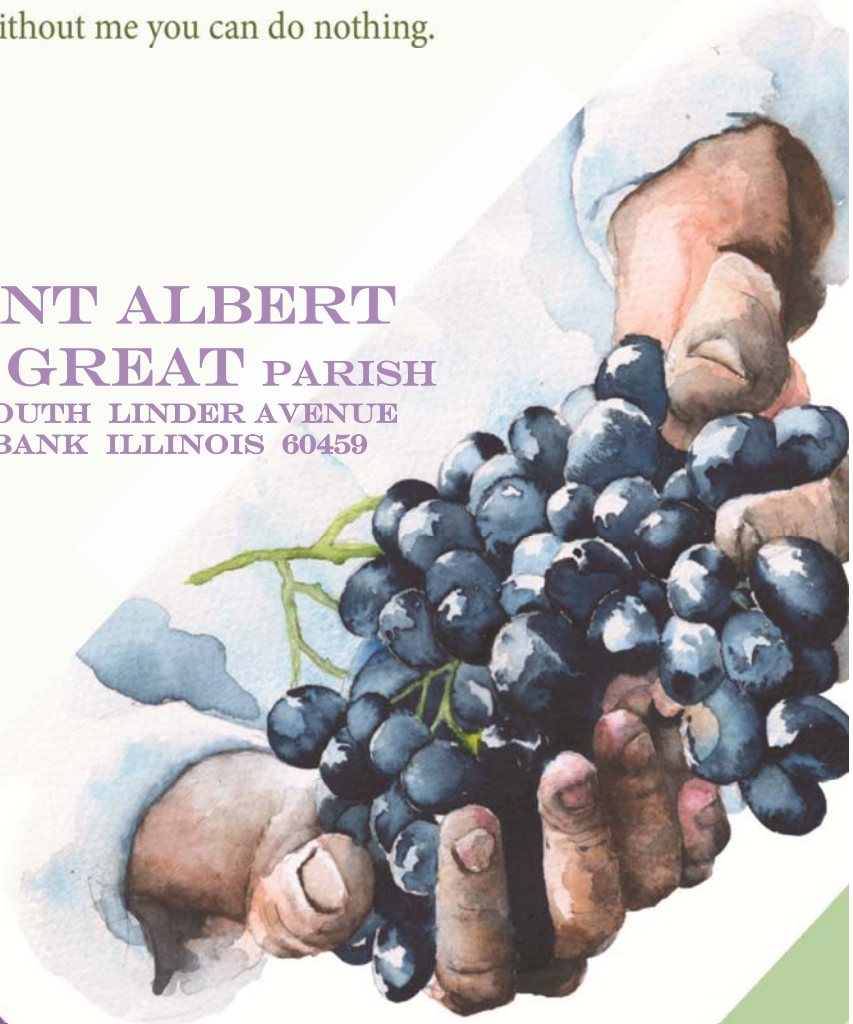

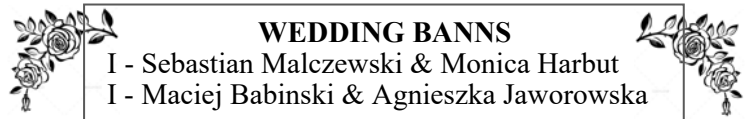

**BEARING FRUIT** Few of us, even when we meditate on the image of the vine and branches, stop to really think about how God "prunes" us. For some there is the danger of thinking that we are already producing fruit for the kingdom, in deed and truth as John says, perhaps raising a family, being active in our parish, and so on. But even those branches which are bearing fruit, the Gospel tells us, can be pruned to produce still more. Today Saul, freshly "pruned" by his conversion, arrives in Jerusalem and meets resistance. Since he had been persecuting Christians, this was only natural. But even after he is accepted and begins to bear fruit, he meets further adversity, and his letters are filled with many accounts of how his trials "pruned" him to produce greater fruit for the kingdom. Like him, as long as we remain in Christ we will continue to bear fruit and, when the will of the Father determines it is time to prune us, the strength of the true vine must enable us to endure it. ### FEAST OF FAITH -The Homily

The ambo, or pulpit, is a special place—it is the place for God's word. That is why it is not used for all the spoken words of the Mass, even important words like the collects and the blessing. The ambo is only used for the scripture readings, and for the homily and the prayer of the faithful. The homily is part of the Liturgy of the Word. It flows from the readings we have just heard, and helps us to understand the way in which God is speaking to us today. The homily is not a lecture, a catechism lesson, or a speech. It is more like an exhortation; it has an urgency about it, for it calls us to find ourselves in the scripture, to live the faith we profess, to see our world by the light of the Gospel. The homily, in itself a response to God's word, demands a response from us. There are many styles of preaching and many ways to respond to the scriptures. But whether the homily is weak or strong, an open ear and an open heart can find in it an abundance of spiritual nourishment. —Corinna Laughlin, Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

Okres Wielkanocy jest bardzo bogaty w różne celebracje w naszym kościele. Dla przykładu podam, że kilka tygodni temu młodzież z naszej parafii (**164 osoby**) przyjęła Sakrament Bierzmowania. Wciąż dzieci (**140**) z naszych szkół przystępują co tydzień do Pierwszej Spowiedzi i Komunii Świętej. Bardzo Was wszystkich proszę o życzliwą modlitwę w ich intencji.

Chcę bardzo serdecznie podziękować wszystkim parafianom i gościom za duchowe i materialne wspieranie naszej parafii oraz dziękuję za wspieranie wszystkich projektów, które systematycznie - krok po kroku - w naszej wspólnocie parafialnej realizujemy. Niech za każde dobro wyświadczone dla naszej parafii i wyświadczone dla drugich Pan Jezus Wam obficie błogosławi!

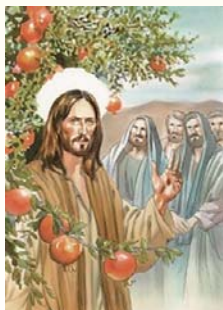

### BYĆ LATOROŚLĄ WYDAJĄCĄ OWOCE!

Zastanawiające jest to, że w wypowiedzi Jezusa, zamieszczonej w dzisiejszej Ewangelii, aż sześć razy pojawia się słowo „owoc”. Mamy przynosić owoc i to owoc obfity, i coraz obfitszy. Tym owocem jest życie człowieka w osiągniętej przez



siebie pełni człowieczeństwa. Tymi owocami Bóg pragnie ubogacać ludzkość.

Życie człowieka staje się owocem twórczego planu Boga, gdy podejmuje on trud postępu duchowego na drodze służby Bogu i bliźnim. Rzeczywiście, taki owoc rodzi się w trudzie i dojrzewa w trudzie, dlatego Jezus zaprasza człowieka do współpracy z Nim: „Beze Mnie nic nie możecie uczynić... Tylko ten, kto trwa we Mnie, a Ja w nim, ten przynosi owoc obfity” (por. J 15, 5). A trwać, to znaczy utrzymywać stałą więź z Chrystusem przez udział w sakramentach św. i pozwolić, by Jego słowa trwały w człowieku z Nim zjednoczonym. Trwać przy Chrystusie, to wydawać owoce dobrych czynów.

Trwanie przy Chrystusie wymaga niekiedy męczeńskiej ofiary. Wspominamy dziś kapłanów, którzy ją złożyli w czasie II wojny światowej. Stali się obfitym owocem oddającym Bogu uwielbienie i chwałę.

Życie człowieka można mierzyć kosztami wspaniałych owoców, które trwać będą wiecznie. Jest to tajemnica życia Kościoła. Pomódlmy się pięknymi strofami poety L. Staffa: „Podejmij, Panie, serce moje jak owoc, który spadł na wicherze za mur Twojego ogrodu – i rzuć tam, gdzie gromadzisz swe wybrane owoce”. Amen. ks. S. Jasionek
