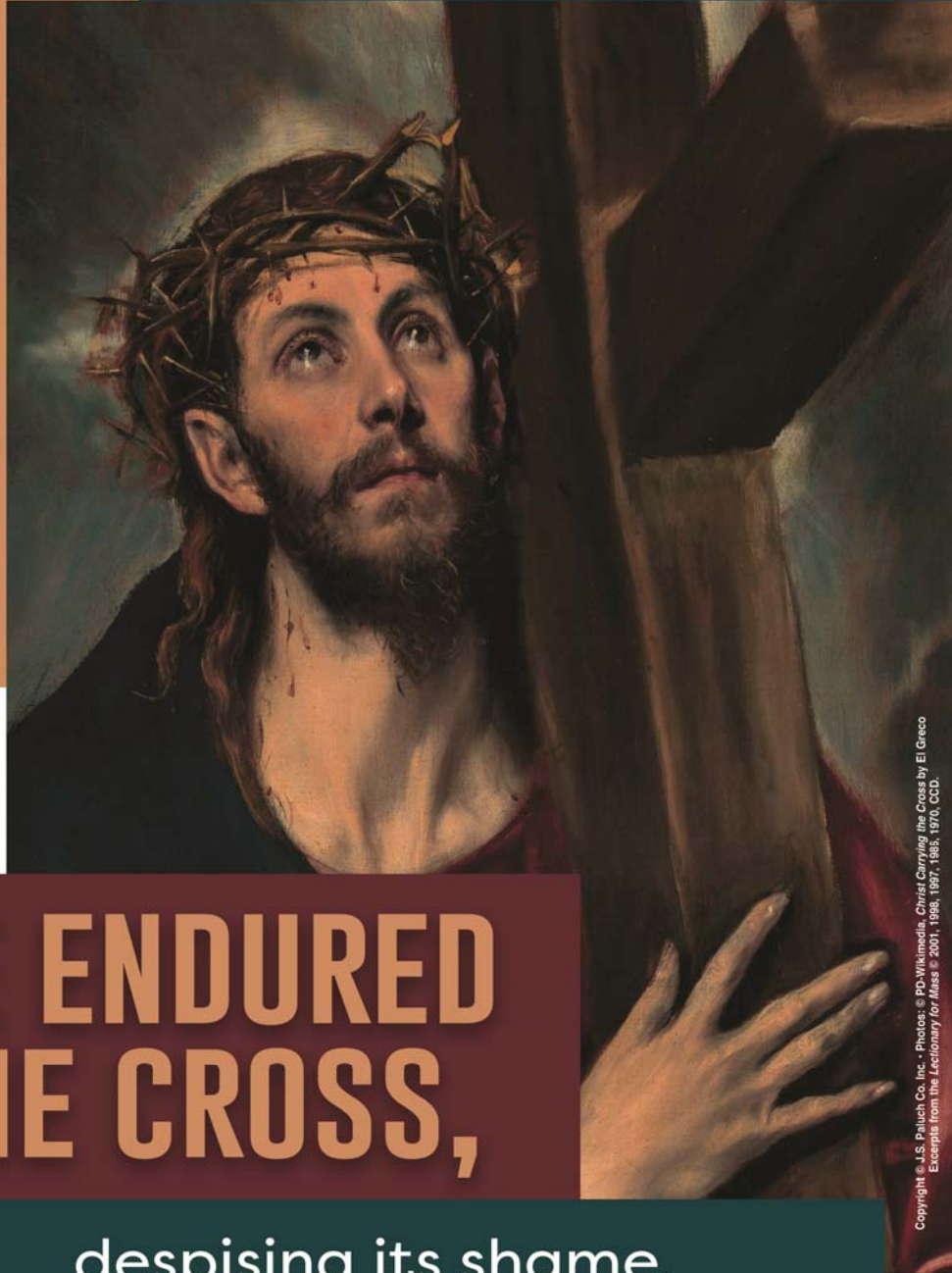

We reflect upon the voice of the prophet in this Sunday's readings. We hear of the suffering and the rescue of Jeremiah. We hear how Jesus anticipates his suffering and death. As with Jeremiah and Jesus, the prophets were sent by God to the leaders and people of Israel. A prophet is one who speaks truth to the powerful, exposing their darker hidden motives and injustices. The prophet presents a way forward that aligns with God's purposes. A prophet can force people away from a comfortable neutrality or indifference. The prophet creates an urgency to make a choice: Are we content with the status quo, or are we to change our ways and pursue a new and better path? Today, we may also ask, how do we identify and respond to prophets of our time? How might we provide a prophetic voice in our Church and in our world?

BÓG OGIEŃ

Nauka Chrystusa z całą pewnością nie jest miętą i bez smaku. To my w swojej zatwardziałości nieustannie ją rozgadujemy, gdyż brakuje nam zapachu, a może odwagi do tego, aby wziąć ją na serio. Gdybyśmy to jednak zrobili, Duch Święty poprowadziłby nas tam, gdzie bije serce chrześcijaństwa, ku pełni zjednoczenia z Jezusem. Tak wiele już słyszeliśmy o Panu Jezusie. Wydaje się nam, że doskonale Go znamy, a Jego nauka nie jest nam obca. Często jednak projektujemy nasze własne wyobrażenia o Nim czy oczekiwania co do Niego i do tych, a nie do Jego rzeczywistej nauki, się stosujemy. Używamy Go do swoich własnych celów, zamykając się na zbawczą moc zawartą w Jego nauczaniu, i jesteśmy rozczarowani, że nasze chrześcijaństwo jest takie jałowe. Jezus nie przyszedł po to, aby przynieść nam dobre samopoczucie. On przyszedł, aby nas wyzwolić, a to może wiązać się z pewnym bólem, przez który musimy przejść. On sam wskazał nam drogę do naśladowania, gdy opuszczony przez swoich uczniów poniósł krzyż dla naszego zbawienia. My także wezwani jesteśmy, aby pójść za Nim, choć nie wszystkim nasz wybór się spodoba i może on zburzyć „święty spokój”, do którego się przyzwyczailiśmy. „Bóg [...] jest ogniem trawiącym. On jest Bogiem zazdrosnym” (Pwt 4,24). Ogień Jego obecności, który oczyszcza wszystko to, co nie-święte, pragnie wypalić nas, abyśmy wolni od grzechu mogli zbliżyć się do Niego.
